Keynote Address: The Islamic Terrorist Threat: Violent and Stealth Jihad The U.S. faces two types of jihad. The first, which most people are familiar with, is the violent jihad, carried out by homegrown Islamic terrorists or those who are activated by Islamic terrorist groups abroad. The second is stealth jihad—which consists of efforts to infiltrate, manipulate and penetrate our society through legal means of electing officials who spout the Muslim Brotherhood line, decry arrests of Islamic terrorists as "racist," try to change educational texts to be more sympathetic to the Muslim Brotherhood, and try to infiltrate such institutions as journalism, the military, the prison system and foreign policy institutes. The stealth jihad follows the secret strategy of the Muslim Brotherhood, whose secret documents were found by the FBI a few years ago in a house in Maryland in connection with the investigation of Hamas in the United States. The stealth jihad is something every law enforcement officer should know more about in order to be able to recognize and stop future terrorist acts on U.S. soil.
