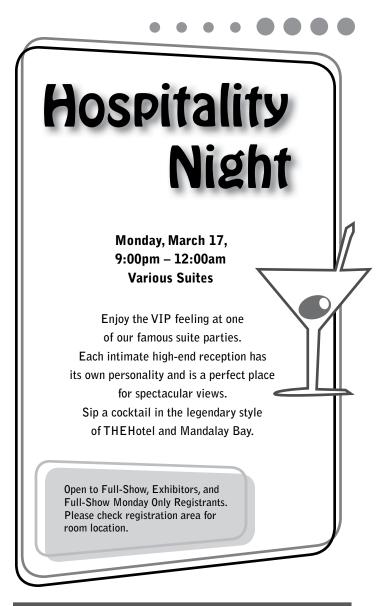

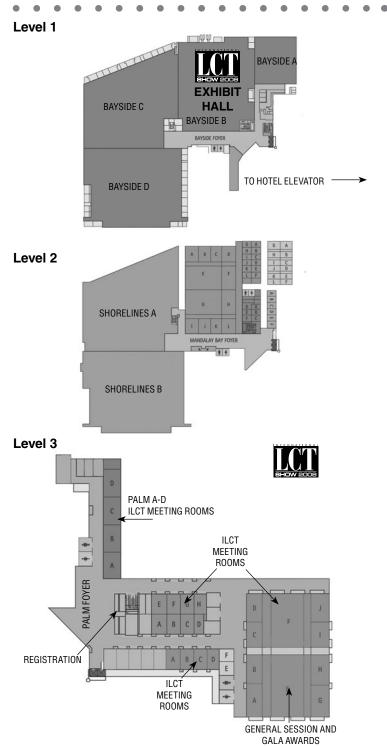

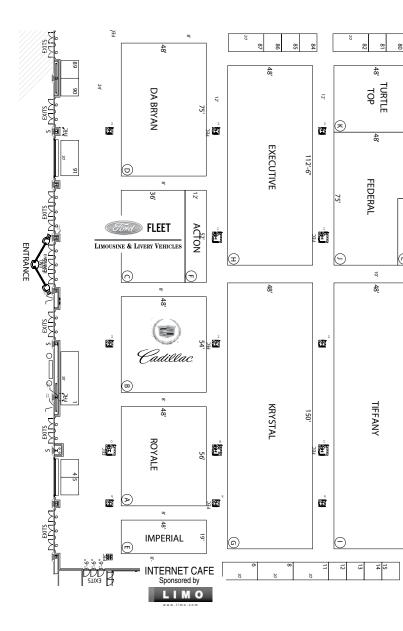

Floor Plan

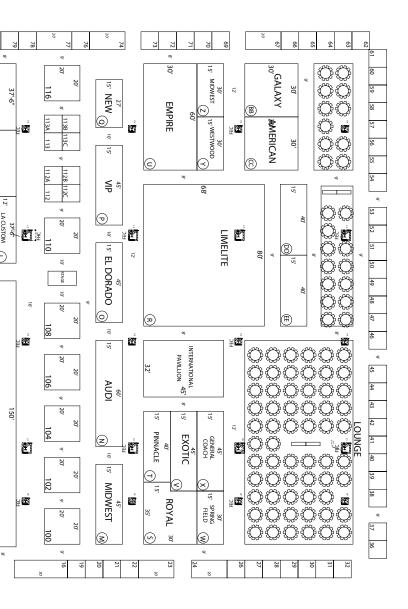
