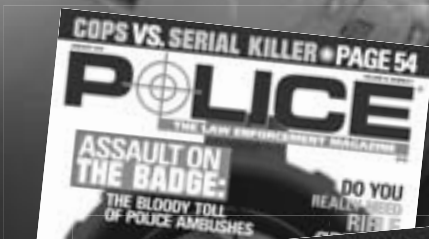

Ground Fighting for Police Officers

Ground fighting for law enforcement will teach the officer how to strike, kick, block, break holds and counter holds while on the ground. The officer will gain confidence fighting from the ground and also learn how to use the ground in an offensive manner. The officer will learn how to fall and roll safely, including with their firearm, and to use falling and rolling both as an offensive technique and as a countering technique. Specific concepts along with relaxation will be employed. Also, a comparison of ground fighting styles will be discussed and how to exploit weaknesses inherent in all styles. This will be a physical class, therefore dress appropriately. Remember, being on your back as a L.E.O. is a dangerous place. It is not like the ring. You have other concerns, such as multiple assailants, weapons and your weapons to consider. This class will give the L.E.O. confidence to ground fight and turn a negative situation into a positive.

The US faces two types of jihad. The first, which most people are familiar with, is the violent jihad, carried out by homegrown Islamic terrorists or those who are activated by Islamic terrorist groups abroad. In 2009, there were 15 attempted or successful Islamic terrorist operations in the United States. The last one in 2009 was the Christmas Day bomber who nearly managed to defeat a \$5 billion

intelligence bureaucracy on counter-terrorism.

The second type of jihad is stealth jihad—which consists of efforts to infiltrate, manipulate and penetrate our society through legal means of electing officials who sprout the Muslim Brotherhood line, who decry arrests of Islamic terrorists as “racist,” who try to change educational texts to be more sympathetic to the Muslim Brotherhood, and who try to infiltrate such institutions as journalism, the military, the prison system and foreign policy institutes. The stealth jihad follows the secret strategy of the Muslim Brotherhood, whose secret documents were found by the FBI a few years ago in a house in Maryland in connection with the investigation of Hamas in the United States.

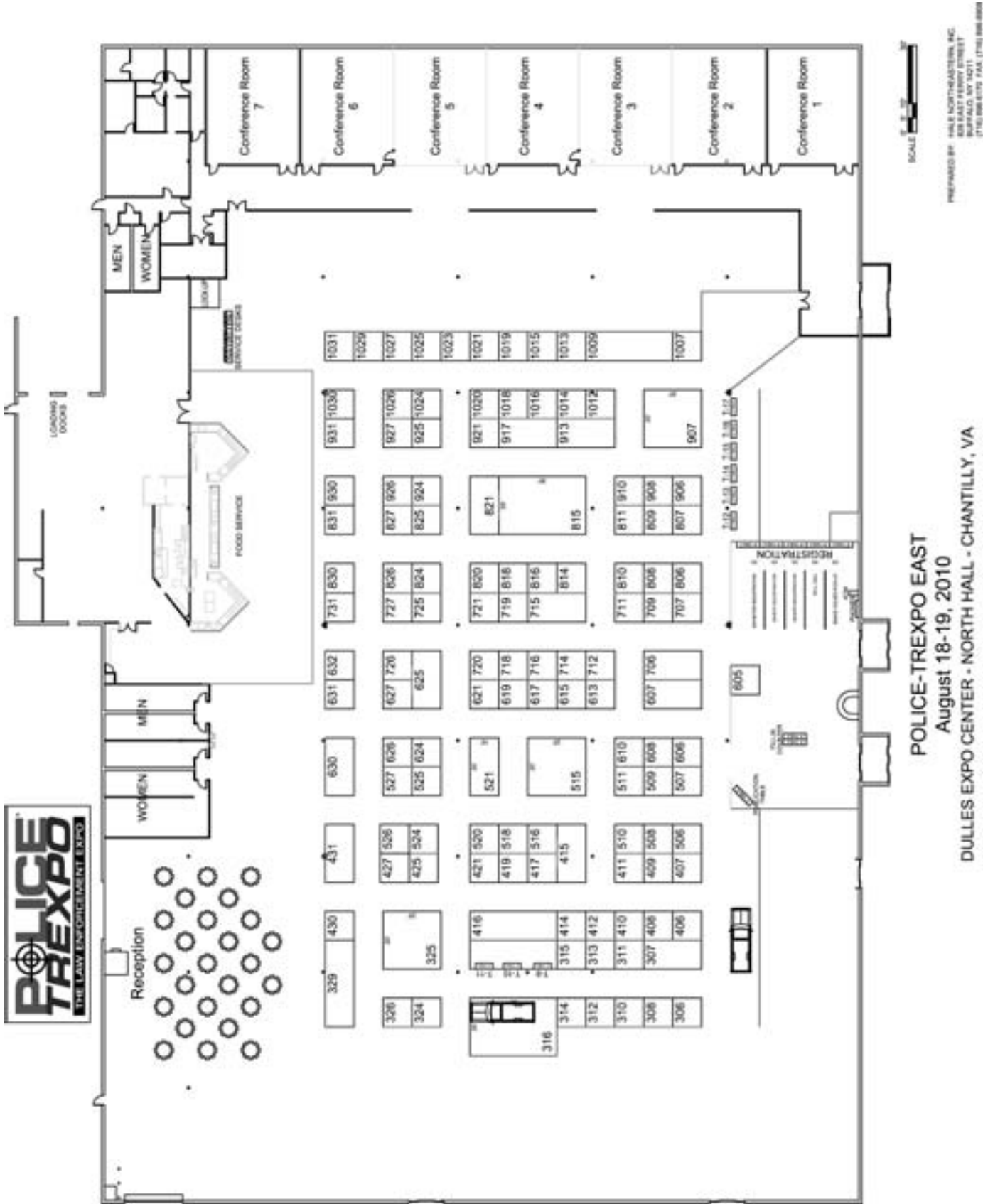

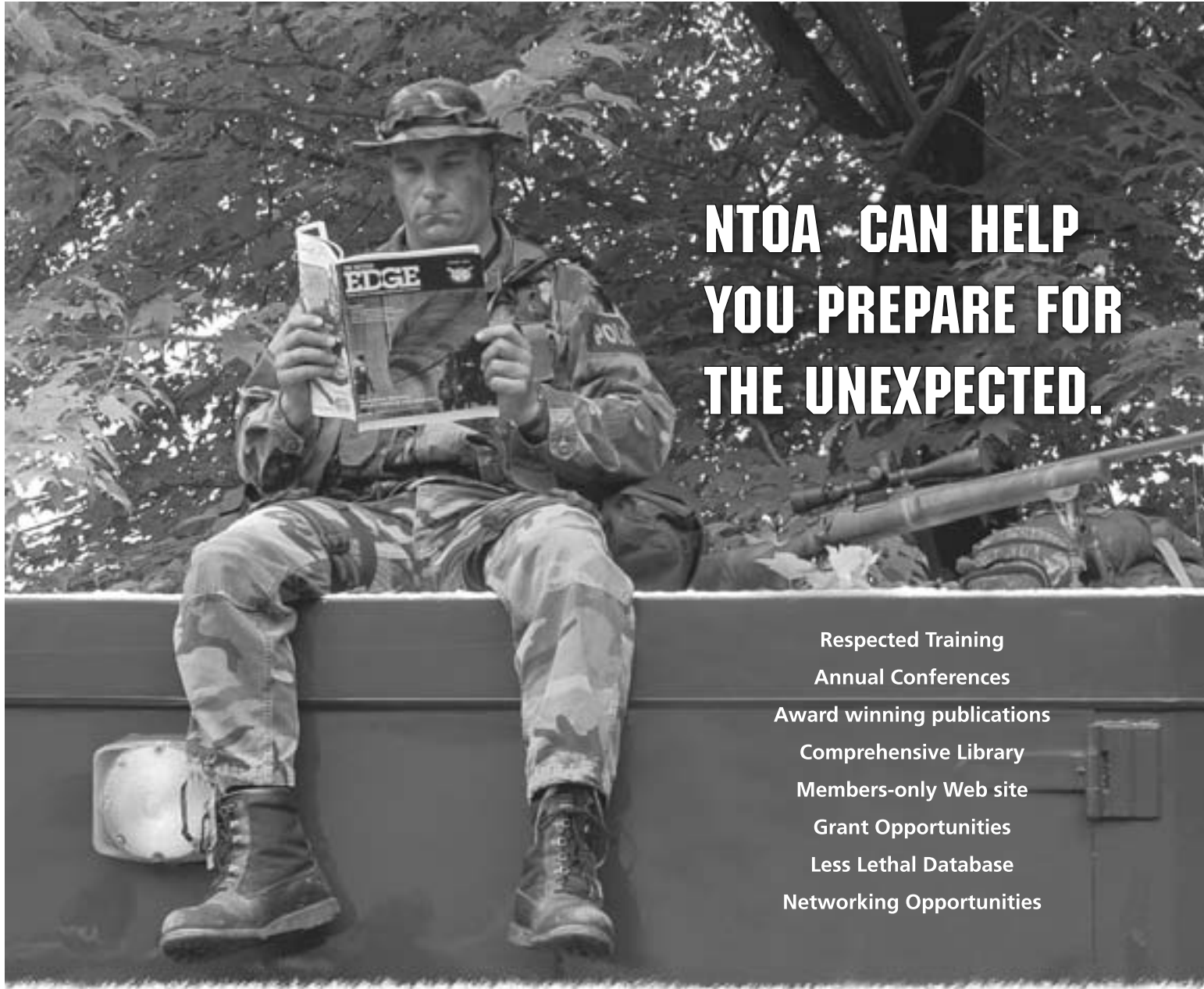
